

Green Champion liaison role

Role description

Where a Green Champion is not already a committee member the Director/Chair of the committee will nominate someone from within the committee membership to be the Green Champion liaison and support the Association's value of sustainability in all the committee's work.

The liaison role will have the support of the Green Champion(s), a role established since 2022 and the National Member elected to Council with responsibility for Sustainability.

The Association works in collaboration with others to improve sustainability in laboratory medicine including BIVDA, NHSE, the Pathology Alliance. We also promote and contribute to the development of accreditation schemes such as My Green Lab and EFLM's green accreditation service. We also make sure all our activities are planned with sustainability at their heart.

Actions for the postholder could include:

- Champion sustainability within the committee by ensuring sustainability is given time on the agenda at any project inception meeting.
- Support committee members to discuss the sustainability of all committee projects, content, events or meetings.
- Receive and pass on feedback from members about sustainability
- Identify case studies and identifying resources to share on the Green Champions webpages.
- Participate in a wider group of sustainability champions to share experience and develop ideas.
