- Work with the staff team to ensure editorial procedures are in place to provide up to date, accurate, peer reviewed quality content for the site.
- Work with the staff team to ensure regular review cycles are completed within defined timescales
- Work with the staff team to ensure the editorial content responds to analytic reports, user feedback and is in keeping with the Association for Laboratory Medicine's style guidelines
- Liaise with the Association for Laboratory Medicine's Green Champions and Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Champions
- Provide regular reports on the status of the content and reviews to the LabTestOnlineUK board
